

Chai with Malachi (Glahn)

This is a four week, book study that will use the Coffee Cup Bible Study workbook to explore the life and times of Malachi. The reader will encounter God's promises and sovereignty on their journey through this study.

Discerning the Voice of God (Shirer)

If hearing God has seemed challenging, Priscilla Shirer's *Discerning the Voice of God* Bible Study will help you explore a relationship with God that will make hearing him an ongoing experience. This 7-session revised and expanded edition reflects her growth through new stories, illustrations, and exercises.

Frequency (Morris)

"How can I hear God?" "Does God still speak?" "Is He speaking to me?" The good news is, yes, God is speaking. And like a radio host broadcasting His voice into the airwaves, God speaks all the time. The question is, "Are you tuned in to the right frequency?" This is a 7 session, DVD based study where you will learn how to dull the constant noises and distractions of life and focus on the voice you long to hear.

Anxious for Nothing (Lucado)

"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Jesus Christ." Philippians 4:4-8

This 6 week, video based study examines this section of Philippians showing how to be anxious about nothing and how to discover true peace with God. (Read alone book also available)

Be Mature: James (Wiersbe)

The book of James squarely focuses on results. His pull-no-punches approach to spiritual maturity, his preference for action over words, makes his text the perfect backdrop for a study of how to grow in our faith.

This is a practical book that deals with overcoming temptation, controlling the tongue, effective prayer, and how to practice what the Bible teaches.

Follow (Stanley)

Regardless of what you believe, regardless of how you behave, Jesus invites you to...Follow. Jesus' message to His first century audience was a message inviting His people into relationship. Stanley takes his readers on a journey through the Gospels as he traces Jesus' teachings on what it means to follow. This is an eight week, video based study.

Romans: Becoming New in Christ (Kuhatschek)

In this 19 week study, learn how to meet God in personal reflection. Help your prayer life to not be stagnant and be reminded why we serve God, becoming new (or renewed) in Christ. Break old patterns and recognize how the world's ways subtly become ours.

Soul Keeping (Ortberg)

Souls become unhealthy and unsatisfied with the false promises of our materialistic world. We often neglect this eternal part of self where we can connect and be fulfilled by our loving God. Ortberg's insight and story filled approach brings relevance and practicality to one of Christianity's most mysterious and neglected topics. 6 Session, Video Based Study.

The Daniel Prayer: Prayer that Moves Heaven and Changes Nations (Graham-Lotz)

Unpack the ancient prayer of Daniel, a prayer that moved heaven and changed a nation. In this 5 week, video based study, you will explore the desperate kind of prayer that storms the gates of heaven and brings results here on earth.

Isaiah, The Lord Saves (Neilson)

Sometimes called the "Romans of the Old Testament," the book of Isaiah is a theological masterpiece. Isaiah holds poetry and gives God's perspective on human history and His redemptive plan. Kathleen Nielson helps us apply this book to ourselves as the people of God and points us to our Savior, the promised Messiah. This study contains 24 lessons.

Proverbs (LifeChange Series)

Proverbs offers practical wisdom for everyday living and provides helpful advice on every aspect both good & bad. Some issues covered are pride, humility, justice, love, lust, friendship and the family. In this Bible study participants will be encouraged to apply God's Word to their life. It includes historical insights, word definitions and discussion questions.
