Join us for an in depth, weekly study of the book of Ephesians. We will be using Living Way Bible Study (13 lessons written by LCMS pastors) along with Dr. Bill Creasy's Audible Commentary to walk through Paul's writings in his letter to the Church of Ephesus as a Roman prisoner. The questions in this study will help apply this New Testament book to modern day life.

GALATIANS FOR YOU: to Read, to Feed, to Lead (by Tim Keller)

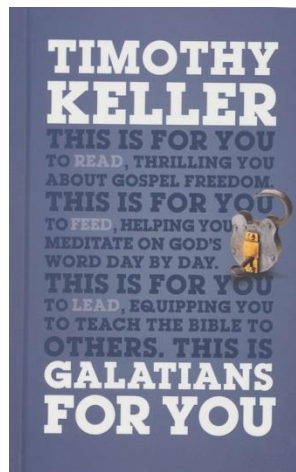
**Meets weekly on Wednsdays at 6:00 pm in Room 201

The choice still confronts us today. This seven-study guide will excite Christians about the gospel, and apply it to every aspect of their lives.
