Qualifications and Expectations

- An acknowledgement that Jesus Christ is your Lord and Savior.
- A desire to continue a strong, committed, and mature relationship with Christ.
- An excitement and interest in helping youth grow in their relationship with God.
- High school graduation date of 2018 or earlier
- Serve as a leader for Confirmation Camp (June 23rd-26th)
- Participate in the High School Mission Trip (July 6th-13th)
- Assist with VBS (July 22nd-25th)

The internship is designed to cover 10 weeks. You would start the week of May 19th and your final week would be the week of July 21st (VBS week). We could also potentially move both the start and end dates a week later if your finals are not completed by May 19th.

The internship is 20 hours per week for 10 weeks. You would work from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to noon on Sunday on the weeks where there wasn't an event. This would allow you to have another job in the afternoon and/or evening.

Compensation/Expenses

You will be compensated \$10/hour for 20 hours/week (plus additional hours for Confirmation Camp, the High School Mission Trip and VBS).

Any expenses related to the internship will be covered. For example, there will not be any expense for you to attend Confirmation Camp or the High School Mission Trip. You will be provided a stipend to cover meals while traveling to the mission trip. All materials needed to complete the internship will be provided for you.
