Opportunities to Serve the Community:

CECELIA PLACE – Thursdays from 10:30-11:15 a.m. we share conversation and a devotion with a group of residents at Cecelia Place, an assisted living facility off of Capitol Drive in Pewaukee. Feel free to join us any Thursday by just showing up. Signing up is not required.

GOD TOUCH MILWAUKEE MINISTRIES – God Touch Milwaukee holds Worship and Bible Study every Tuesday and Thursday at 5:30 p.m. Join the men and women of the God Touch house and neighborhood at 2235 S. 17th Street, Milwaukee. They serve a meal with fellowship before each service. Come as you are! We also support many service projects throughout the year at God Touch Milwaukee, such as distributing Easter baskets, school backpacks, cooking/serving at picnics, etc.

HOPE CENTER – Hope Center of Waukesha gives us two opportunities to serve the people of Waukesha. Three times a year you can help prepare and serve breakfast to those in need. Or, three times a year you can help serve dinner to the people in the neighborhood of Hope Center.

HOPE STREET MINISTRY – We partner with Hope Street on 26th and Capitol Drive in Milwaukee with an Annual Family Picnic as well as serving in other events they may have throughout the year.

HOUSE OF CORRECTION – Do you have a heart for prison fellowship? House of correction gives us opportunities throughout the year to join them for different events, often times with short notice. Background checks will be required.

MISSION OF CHRIST DELIVERER – Assist in delivering clothing and household items to Mission of Christ. Deliveries are made from 8:00 a.m.-Noon the 3rd Saturday of each month.

MISSION OF CHRIST TREAT BAKER – Help Shepherd minister to the clients of Mission of Christ's household & food pantry. We provide treats every other month. Participate in this blessing by baking 3-4 dozen of your favorite treat. Treats should be packaged to "grab & go" and need to be at church no later than 8:00 a.m. on the date specified.

SLEEPING MATS FOR HUMANITY – Please join us as we recycle plastic grocery bags and create sleeping mats for the homeless and other people in need. We meet the 3rd Saturday of every month through May 2020 from 9:30-11:30 a.m. We are looking for help sorting, flattening and folding plastic grocery bags; cutting the bags into strips; tying the strips together; or crocheting or weaving the strips into mats.

ST. MARTINI LUTHERAN CHURCH – There is an opportunity to join Pastor Dan and Pastor Prada of St. Martini at a weekly Gathering at St. Martini Lutheran School, 1520 S. Cesar E. Chavez Drive, Milwaukee. This faith gathering is held every Thursday, at 6:00-7:30 p.m. We will gather for a combination of social interaction, spiritual conversation (specifically exploring the life of Jesus), discipleship (helping one another grow in our character and lifestyle to be more like Jesus), worship (unplugged, intimate and raw), prayer, food and mission.

ZACHARIAH'S ACRES – Zachariah's Acres hosts two fall events that provide volunteer opportunities each year. Their Fall Harvest Fest in September and their Trail Run/Walk/Roll in October. Help is needed in all areas from directing participants, games, hay rides, crafts, and serving refreshments, to cheering runners on. These opportunities are for ages 12 and up (all children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or adult).
