Opportunities to Serve:

Greeter – Be a friendly face to greet and welcome people, provide assistance to visitors who may need directions to the nursery, Kidz Konnection, etc. Serve approximately once every four weeks for about 20 minutes prior to the start of service.

Usher – Greet people, hand out bulletins, assist people with finding open seating, collect offering, direct people to communion, and minimal clean up at the end of service. Once a month commitment for about 1 ½ hours. Training provided.

Communion Set Up & Clean Up – Replenish communion trays and set altar for communion between services. Serve approximately once a month for about 20 minutes pre or post service depending on the worship service. Training provided.

Kitchen – Prepare and clean up the coffee, lemonade and donuts on Sunday mornings. Serve approximately once every four weeks for about 20 minutes pre or post service depending on the worship service. Training provided.

Donut Pick Up – Pick up donuts at Pewaukee Pick N Save at 7:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings and deliver them to church. Serve approximately once every four weeks. Training provided.

Information Center – Be a friendly face to members and guests, provide assistance with questions they have about upcoming activities, events, classes, etc. Give out complimentary Bibles to those that request them and gifts to visitors. Training provided.

Flower Pick Up – Pick floral arrangements up at Sussex Pick N Save on either Friday or Saturday and deliver them to church. Typically, you will be scheduled for a month at a time (all the Sundays in that month). Serve approximately every 5 to 6 months.

Wedding Hostess – Provide direction, support, and hospitality to the bride and groom, wedding party, and their families. This is accomplished through the three primary aspects of the role: assisting with advance planning, being present at the wedding rehearsal, and coordinating/overseeing the activities before, during and after the wedding. Serve one to two times per year...rehearsal is approximately an hour of your time and the day of the wedding is about four hours. Training is provided.

Baptismal Banner Builder – Assemble banners to be displayed in church for baptisms. Serve approximately once a month. Day and time are based on your availability. Training provided.

Busy Bags – Replenish Busy Bags that children use at worship services. Serve approximately 1 ½ hours every four to six weeks. Day and time are based on your availability. Training provided.
